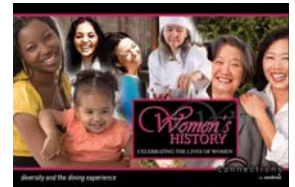
March is Women's History Month

In February 1980, President Jimmy Carter declared the week of March 2-8 as National Women's History Week. In his decree, he stated "I urge libraries, schools, and community organizations to focus their observances on the leaders who struggled for equality - - Susan B. Anthony, Sojourner Truth, Lucy Stone, Lucretia Mott, Elizabeth Cady Stanton, Harriet Tubman, and Alice Paul. Understanding the true history of our country will help us to comprehend the need for full equality under the law for all our people."

In 1987, Congress made declared March Women's History Month in perpetuity. Each
